



In this new sudoku variant, standard sudoku rules apply—that is, each digit from 1 through 9 must appear exactly once in each row, in each column, and in each 3×3 block. (Note that the 3×3 blocks are not outlined.) In addition, each grid is divided into gray and pink regions (outlined in black) where N = the number of squares in that region. Each pink region will contain digits from 1 to N, while each gray region will contain digits from 10–N to 9. For example, a pink region of area 4 contains digits from 1 to 4, while a gray region of area 4 contains numbers from 6 to 9. ANSWERS, PAGE 75
